<p>1. When Jesus was born, who was king of Judea?</p> <p>Solomon <i>Herod</i> Caesar Augustus</p>	<p>2. How many wise men came to see Jesus?</p> <p>Three Four <i>The Bible doesn't say.</i></p>
<p>3. True or false: The wise men were kings.</p> <p><i>False – they were probably astrologers, people who studied the stars and interpreted them.</i></p>	<p>4. Where did the wise men come from?</p> <p><i>The East.</i> The West Jerusalem</p>

<p>5. Why did the wise men leave home?</p> <p>They wanted to see the world.</p> <p>They were afraid of Herod.</p> <p><i>They saw a star, interpreted it to mean a king was born, and followed it to worship the new king.</i></p>	<p>6. Where did the wise men stop to ask about the child?</p> <p><i>Jerusalem.</i></p> <p>Egypt</p> <p>Nazareth.</p>
<p>7. How did Herod feel when he heard about the wise men's question?</p> <p><i>Worried</i></p> <p>Excited</p> <p>Sad.</p>	<p>8. When Herod heard about the wise men, he called together the chief priests and religious teachers. What did he ask them?</p> <p>What do you think about those wise guys?</p> <p><i>"Where will the Messiah be born?"</i></p> <p>When did the star appear?</p>

When Herod asked the religious leaders where the Messiah would be born, what did they tell him?</p> <p>"He will be born in Egypt, just as the prophet wrote."</p> <p>"He will be born in Nazareth, just as the prophet wrote."</p> <p><i>"He will be born in Bethlehem, just as the prophet wrote."</i></p>	<p>10. Herod secretly called in the wise men. What did he ask them?</p> <p><i>When they had first seen the star.</i></p> <p>What gifts they were bringing.</p> <p>What was the name of the child?</p>

After the wise men answered Herod's question, what did he tell them?</p> <p>Go to Bethlehem and kill all the boys two years old or younger.</p> <p><i>"Go to Bethlehem and search carefully for the child. As soon as you find him, let me know. I want to go and worship him too."</i></p> <p>Go to Bethlehem and give the child some gifts from me, too.</p>	<p>12. When Herod told the wise men he wanted to worship the new king, was he telling the truth?</p> <p>Yes. He was excited that the Messiah had come.</p> <p><i>No. He wanted to kill the child.</i></p>

After the wise men talked to Herod, what did they do?</p> <p><i>They followed the star until they came to the place where Jesus was.</i></p> <p>They went to Bethlehem and asked around until they found Jesus.</p> <p>They followed the star to Egypt.</p>	<p>14. When the wise men went into the house where Jesus was, whom did they see?</p> <p>Mary and Joseph.</p> <p><i>Jesus and Mary.</i></p> <p>Jesus and Joseph.</p>

<p>15. When the wise men saw Jesus, what did they do?</p> <p>They got down on the floor and played with him.</p> <p>They warned his parents about Herod.</p> <p><i>They knelt down and worshiped Jesus. They gave him gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh.</i></p>	<p>16. What did the wise men say to the shepherds?</p> <p>Look out! My camel is about to step on your sheep!</p> <p>May we follow you to Bethlehem?</p> <p><i>Nothing. The shepherds are in a different passage and visited at a different time.</i></p>
<p>17. After the wise men met Jesus, they were warned in a dream about something. What was it?</p> <p>Not to tell anyone they had seen Jesus.</p> <p><i>Not to return to Herod</i></p> <p>To hurry away to Egypt.</p>	<p>18. After the wise men found Jesus, how did they avoid seeing Herod again?</p> <p>They dressed in disguises.</p> <p>They hurried through Jerusalem without stopping.</p> <p><i>They went home by a different road.</i></p>

When Herod found out that the wise men had tricked him, what did he do?</p> <p><i>He ordered his men to kill all the boys who lived in or near Bethlehem and were two years old and younger.</i></p> <p>He ordered his men to kill the wise men.</p> <p>He ordered his men to kill Mary and Joseph.</p>	<p>20. Why did Herod choose two years or younger as the age of boys to be killed?</p> <p>He hated little children.</p> <p><i>Based on what the wise men told him about when they had first seen the star.</i></p> <p>Based on what the chief priest told him.</p>
<p>21. After the wise men had gone, Joseph also had a warning in a dream. What was it?</p> <p>Not to tell anyone about the wise men.</p> <p>To hurry and take Jesus and Mary to Nazareth.</p> <p><i>To hurry and take Jesus and Mary to Egypt.</i></p>	<p>22.
