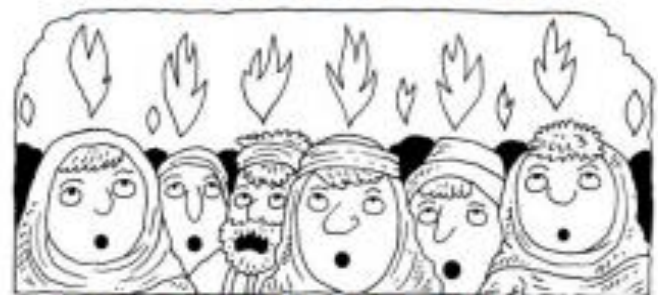
Before Jesus went up to heaven he told his disciples to wait in Jerusalem until they had power from God.
