

The Stable That Bob Built

Story Book Summary – Christmas Pageant performed by the VeggieTales in the format of “The House that Jack Built”.

We used this book as a narrated Christmas Skit.

Backdrop - Stable

12 Cast (If you have extra kids you could add additional animals (example): cow that mooed, *the ox that snorted*, and *the chicken that clucked*, in the stable that Bob built.)

Below is Cast Sheet, which includes simple costume, props, and action suggestions. Our Narrator paused after a character’s name was said, for that character to say/do their action we came up with, as noted below.

Character	Student’s Name	Costume/Props/Actions	
Bob the Builder		Black Apron with toy tools in front pockets, toy hammer in hand, yellow construction hat Action – Hammer Stable wall twice and say “I’m a really good builder!”	
Cow		Cow Costume – Action – says “Moo”	
Guy <i>We changed to Innkeeper</i>		Innkeeper Hat & Blue Bath Robe Pulled a Black Sheep across stage, pausing to look at congregation and say, “I don’t know how to milk a cow.” Raising hands in a shrug like he’s confused.	
Lambs		Wore Sheep hat (pictured). We have two wooden sheep on wheels, one is black, one is white (someone at our church in years past had built.) Action: Pulls White Sheep across stage and says, “Baa”.	
Shepherd		Brown Hat & House Coat / Staff / Pie (Toy Pie or Tart) Action: Says, “I Love Pie!” and pretends to take a bite from the pie in their hand.	
Angel		Silver Headband, Small White Choir Gown, White Wings Action: come here action, with hand, and points the way	
Mary		Pink Dress and Pink Scarf Actions: Bows lady like	
Joseph		Blue Hat & House Coat Action: Hugs Mary	
Star		Star Costume Action: raises arms like they’re shining	
3 Wise Men		Crowns (we did not have enough kids, so three men from the congregation rose and joined the cast on stage (they’d been given just a crown to wear in advance). Action: Walks in place	
Baby Jesus		Manger and Baby Doll wrapped in blanket
